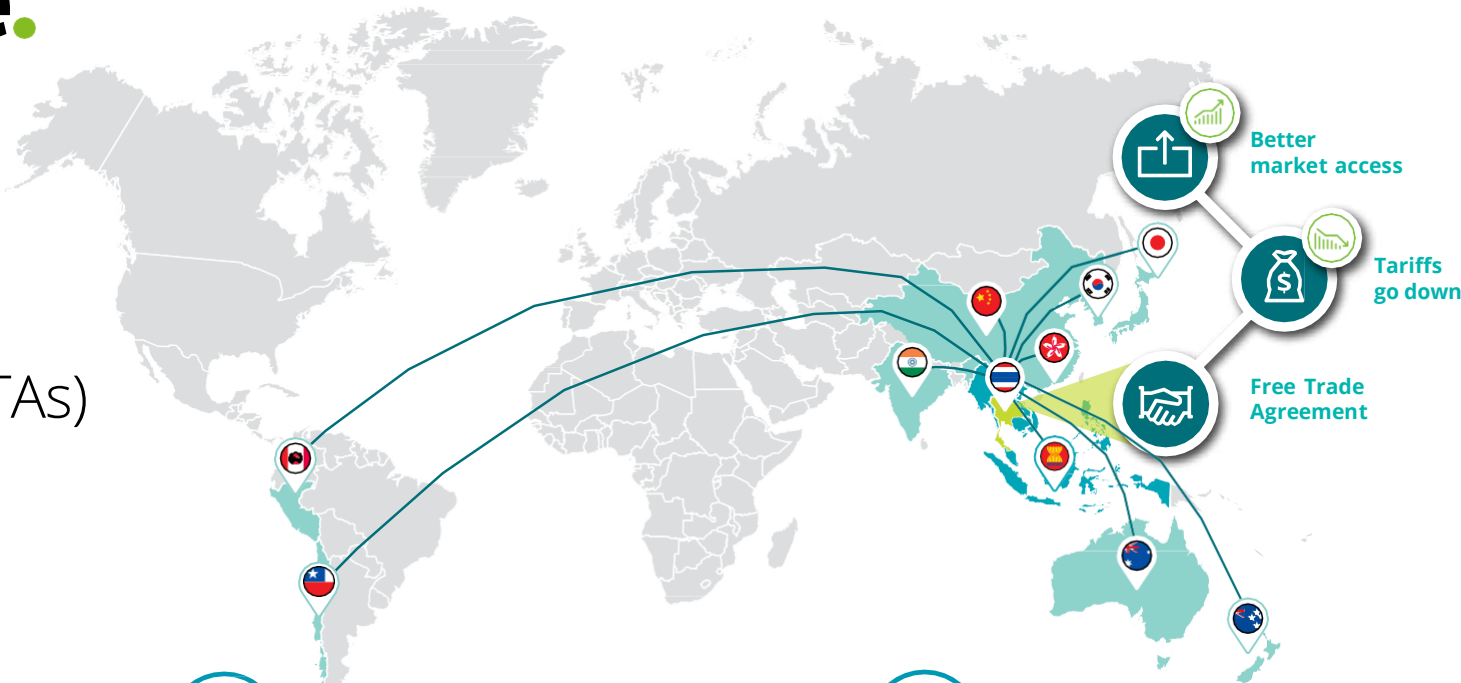




# Global Trade Advisory Free Trade Agreement (FTAs)



### What are FTAs?

- Thailand and other countries agree to reduce or eliminate tariffs on each others' imports.
- Thailand has FTAs and trade preferences with ASEAN countries, China, Hong Kong, Japan, India, Korea, Australia, New Zealand, Peru, and Chile.
- Thailand is a party to the newly established RCEP



### What are the benefits of FTAs?

- Better market access for products from countries in the FTA;
- Countries that are not party to the FTA, do not receive the same benefits;
- FTAs cut costs for imports and increase competitiveness of exports.
